



PLANT UPGRADE MEB General Contractors, which has offices in Chesapeake and Richmond, has completed the EDR or electro dialysis reversal system at Suffolk's G. Robert House Water Treatment Plant, doubling the plant's daily groundwater treatment capacity. The project combined an expansion of the existing treatment plant, a new well source and a pipeline connecting the two. EDR is an electrochemical separation process that removes ions and other charged species from water and other fluids, which allows 94 percent of the water to be recovered. The G. Robert House plant provides water for the city of Suffolk and Isle of Wight County as part of the Western Tidewater Regional Water Authority.
